

'Introduction of online Disembarkation Card (E-Arrival Card)'

Government of India has replaced the physical disembarkation card (arrival card) with a digital disembarkation card (e-Arrival card) w.e.f 01.10.2025. All foreign travellers visiting India should complete the online form 72 hours prior to their arrival in India.

The e-Arrival card can be filled up through the online official platforms: the Bureau of Immigration website (<https://boi.gov.in>), the official Indian Visa website (<https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/earrival/>) and also through the Official Mobile App "Indian Visa Su-Swagatam".

The digital form requires the Full Name, Nationality, Passport Number, Purpose of Visit, Date of Arrival, Address and Contact/Emergency Contact details in India. Filling up of digital disembarkation card will help foreigners arriving in India avoid delays at immigration counters and make the immigration process easier.
